## Hoag Classic and Chipotle "Chip-In" for Kindness with Grants to Local Newport Mesa Unified Schools

Five Newport Mesa Unified School District (NMUSD) schools have each been awarded a \$1,000 grant to implement programs that foster kindness in their communities.

The Hoag Classic and Chipotle are proud to announce that Corona Del Mar Middle School, TeWinkle Middle School, Early College High School, Estancia High School and Back Bay High School have been selected as the first-ever recipients of the "Chip-In" for Kindness Grant.

"The Hoag Classic is proud to support local students through initiatives like Student Day, which encourages young fans to engage with the tournament in a meaningful way," said Andrew Guarni, Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of Hoag. "Thanks to Chipotle's generosity, the 'Chip-In' for Kindness Grant will help foster a culture of kindness in our schools, aligning with our commitment to giving back to the community and inspiring the next generation."

These grants will support kindness initiatives reaching more than 2,500 students across the five campuses. Student-led projects that the "Chip-In" for Kindness Grant will help implement include:

- Estancia High School's Acts of Random Kindness Club will coordinate a week
  of special activities on campus that specifically address kindness, bullying and
  resiliency in the face of challenges.
- The grant will provide Back Bay High School with necessary resources to transform and enhance their existing wellness garden into a space that fosters kindness, mindfulness and connection among students and staff.







- TeWinkle Middle School will use the essential funding to implement and sustain the Kindness Cart Days project. Students organize and manage a mobile Kindness Cart with small treats, school supplies and motivational notes.
- Early College High School plans to use the grant to help fund supplies for the Kindness Plant Garden near the Kindness Rock Garden that was created in November 2024.
- The Student Voices team at Corona del Mar Middle/High School will use funds to purchase rewards like gift cards and school merchandise to encourage students to show kindness by caring for shared spaces on campus.

"Through our purpose to Cultivate a Better World, we are committed to investing in the communities we serve," said Laurie Schalow, Chief Corporate Affairs Officer of Chipotle. "Given our strong connection to Orange County with a Restaurant Support Center in Newport Beach, it's important for us to partner with likeminded local organizations like Hoag and inspire positive experiences for kids in the area."

The celebration continues during the Final Round of the Hoag Classic PGA Tour Champions event on Sunday, March 23, with Student Day presented by Kingston Technology. Attendees ages 18 and younger, including students from the schools selected as recipients of the "Chip-In" for Kindness Grant initiative, will receive complimentary admission.

Family-friendly activities include the Chipotle School Spirit Challenge, inviting fans to wear school colors; the Chipotle "Chip"ping Clinic presented by First Tee; as well as the Kingston Autograph Arena to meet-and-greet with players from 2 to 4 p.m.
